

Title: South-East Asia Regulatory Network Quality Policy

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The South-East Asia Regulatory Network (SEARN) is a volunteer association of the National Regulatory Authorities from the South-East Asia WHO region, responsible for the regulation of medical products. SEARN is committed to implement a quality management system (QMS) and to guarantee that it consistently meets its stakeholders' requirements by:

- 1. Supporting timely access to affordable medical products of assured quality, safety and efficacy in all countries of the South-East Asia region and beyond.
- 2. Ensuring that quality objectives are established and implemented in accordance with SEARN Terms of Reference.
- 3. Developing and strengthening regulatory collaboration, convergence and reliance in a sustainable manner, to optimize the use of existing regulatory capacities and expertise and address common issues and areas of work.
- 4. Ensuring information sharing between SEARN Members.
- 5. Strengthening regulatory systems in the region.
- 6. Promoting alignment of regulatory approaches and requirements based on international standards and good regulatory practices.

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
