3. Developing and strengthening regulatory collaboration, convergence and reliance in a sustainable manner, to optimize the use of existing regulatory capacities and expertise and address common issues and areas of work.
4. Ensuring information sharing between SEARN Members.
5. Strengthening regulatory systems in the region.
6. Promoting alignment of regulatory approaches and requirements based on international standards and good regulatory practices.
